INSPEC²T in GlobalTechCity event Amsterdam, The Netherlands May 1, 2017

CGI participated in the Global Tech City event in Amsterdam on May 1, 2017.

CGI was an invited speaker for the GlobalTechCity event in Amsterdam. The INSPEC²T presentation was featured in the industry track and the speech aimed at Public Safety and educating citizens to participate in digital community policing actions for Public Safety and creating safer communities. The GlobalTechCity is a recently established and rapidly growing event series which engages communities to discuss topics on digital and tech cities.

This event was very focused and gathered some 60 selected international multidisciplinary participants including students, industry/business representatives such as Microsoft, academia such as Amsterdam University of Applied Sciences (AUAS) and Baden Wattenberg Cooperative State University (Germany), municipal governance representatives such as Amsterdam City, community representatives and security, data protection and innovation experts.

During the industry track, Dr. Gohar Sargsyan presented the INSPEC²T project, the achievements so far, the challenges and the next steps.

INSPEC²T was received by the audience as an excellent example of a European Public Private People Partnership bringing value to each other and creating safer communities. It was also well accepted that it is important to educate citizens to participate in digital community policing actions.

The participants of the event expressed high interest not only in the citizens' participation in the community policing action but also in the technical solution provided within the framework of the project.
