INSPEC²T presented at the 20th European Police Congress



INSPEC²T presented at the 20th European Police Congress hosted in Berlin on February 21st and 22nd 2017.

The Valencia Local Police (PLV) was one of the LEAs invited to speak at the [20th European Police Congress](#) hosted in Berlin on February 21st and 22nd 2017.

The 20th European Police Congress, organised by the newspaper Behörden Spiegel, dealt with the topic “Europe – boundless? Liberty, mobility, security“. The two-day programme included more than 20 panel sessions, where numerous strategic and technical topics were discussed. The European Police Congress is Europe’s leading conference-fair on homeland security, with approximately 1,600 national and international participants taking part.

In this framework, PLV was invited to participate in the “Smart Policing” Panel session that took place on February 21st and which gathered an estimated audience of 400 participants, mainly comprising of LEAs and members of the Security Industry. Smart Policing implies the use of new technologies as a police strategy to facilitate conflict resolution and to enhance communication between the Community Policing police officers and citizens. In that sense, INSPEC²T was presented as an example of smart policing in Europe.
