CGI sponsored the Smart Cities event in Montreal, Quebec, Canada from October 22-23, 2015.

CGI was a sponsor of the Smart Cities event with participation of the prime minister of Quebec, Mr. Philippe Couillard. The event was organized by Les Affaires, Quebec. Les Affaires is a French-language weekly newspaper publishing 46 issues per year. It is available on newsstands throughout Quebec. This was the second edition of the Les Affaires series, which was dedicated to Smart Cities and city management engaging their citizens.

The event gathered decision makers of the municipal sector on the one hand and business/technology leaders on the other hand, for them to learn more about the major trends in time and see the returns on investment that cities have focused on innovation to accelerate their development.

CGI hosted a one-hour session: "Les villes intelligentes et leurs citoyens: réussir le virage numérique" (in English "Smart cities and their citizens: Succeeding in the digital transition").
